Bible Passage

Our new series is all about 'Why We need Jesus?'. Today we will look at a parable Jesus told.

You can find it in your Bible in : Matthew 7 v 24-27

Read the psalm together – choose a translation or children's bible which will be easy to read as a group. (If you don't have a bible you can download one for free on your phone or use biblegateway.com)

# Discussion

In the section before todays passage (ch5-7. You could try to read a little of this this week!), Jesus has been teaching about how those who belong to His kingdom live; they are pure in heart, forgiving and generous. Today he is teaching about what we build our lives on.

Have a go at answering these questions together:

What will wise people do with Jesus' words? What will foolish people do? (v24&26)

What is the difference between what happens to the wise builder and the foolish one? (v25&27)

#### What does Jesus want us to learn?

Now watch the video in the email for a little more information. Jesus tells us that we need to realise that on our own we are not any of those things He had been teaching. We need to hear Jesus words and obey them, this is like building on a rock. Our rock is Jesus, If we build our lives on anything else the foundations could be washed away in an instant like the sand.

### Prayer

Dear God, help me to depend on you. Help me to listen to what you say and to do it. Amen.

Don't forget to also pray for any who are unwell or lonely in these times.

We need Jesus! His teaching is the only

safe foundation for our lives.

# Family Activity

You will need: building materials from around your house. (e.g. cereal boxes and Sellotape or playdough, or lego etc.

To make sure your house didn't fall over the base needed to be strong. We need to have a strong base for our lives, like the man who built on the rock. Jesus is our rock to build our lives on.




