AT HOME

Psalm 139

The aim of the activity sheets we will be sending out is to get all the family involved by learning together, crafting and talking about the reason Easter is so special and more about Jesus who helps us in these difficult times. Start with the 'Bible Passage' box and continue in any order from there.

Bible Passage

This is our fourth week in Psalms. You can find it in your Bible in :

Psalm 139

Read the psalm together – choose a translation or children's bible which will be easy to read as a group. (If you don't have a bible you can download one for free on your phone or use biblegateway.com)

Discussion

God **knows** us. God is **with** us. God **saves** us.

1. God **knows** us: have a go at playing the game in the family activity section. We can see this in verse 1-6 and again in v13-18. God knew us before we were even born... before our mums and dads. God made us perfect for Him, we are wonderfully made!
2. God is **with** us: God knows everything but is also with us everywhere we see this in v7-12. David asks a question in v7 but he is really telling us that we can't hide from God, but that he doesn't hide from us either – He loves us and so will never leave us. This reminds us of [Joshua ch1 v 9](#). It was our memory verse at Adventurers – see you can remember it or look it up in your bible.
3. God **saves** us: in v19-24 God is a Saviour. Lets look at verses 23-24. God already knows all about us, but David invites God to be in his heart in v23. God is always with us but David asks God to be with him, to show us the things he has done wrong, and to guide him.

Questions for Parents & Children:

Have you asked Jesus into your heart by inviting Him in?

Have you asked Him to show you the things in your heart that are bad? Have you asked Him to be your guide?

Memory Verse

Psalm 139 v14

"I will praise you for I am fearfully and wonderfully made. Your works are wonderful. I know that full well."

Prayer

'Jesus please come into my heart, come in stay and guide me through life. Thank you that you died to save me, and you will never leave me. Amen'

Don't forget to also pray for any friends and family that are unwell or alone.

Family Activity

Play a game of guess who with your family.

Take it in turns to think of a person in your head – it could be someone that you know or somebody famous or from the TV. But you must keep it a **secret**. Now your family will ask you questions so they can guess who it is. You can only answer yes or no! See who can guess each others 'person' first!

When you have your 'secret' person in your head – no one else knows who it is – they have to guess or ask questions to find out more information. But God doesn't need to ask questions because he already knows everything about us – good and bad. We are told about his in v1 and then in v2-5 there are some word pictures to show us God knows all about us. In v6 David says it is too much for him to understand!

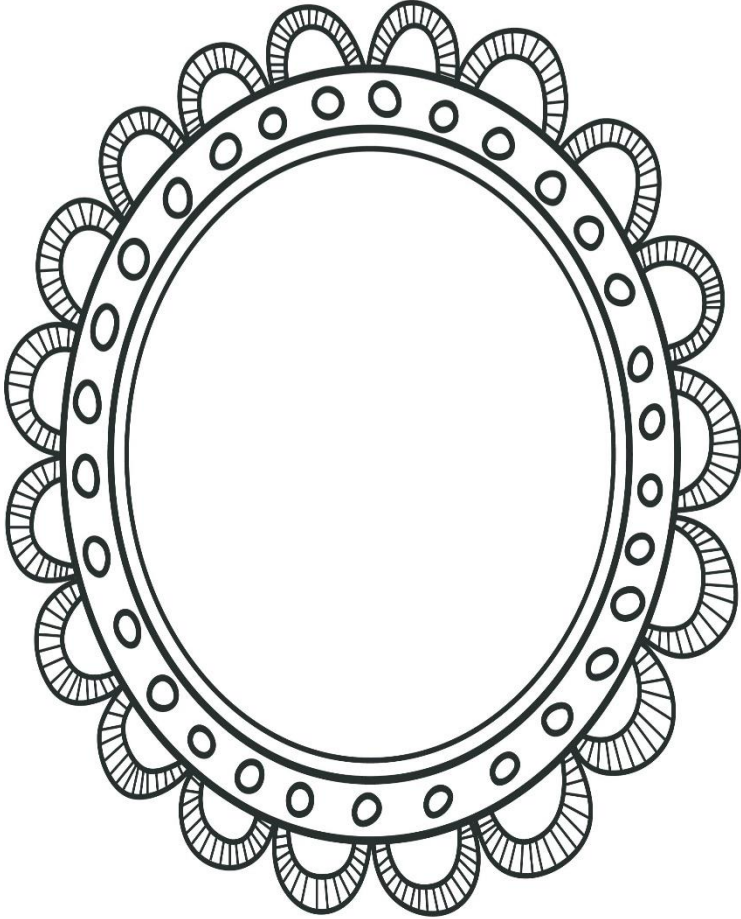

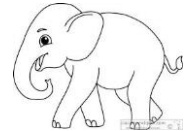
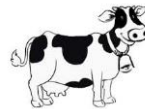
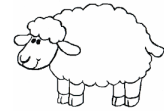
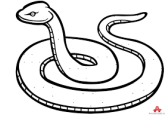


WONDERFULLY MADE.
